FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by James Thomas Campbell in the office of the State Engineer on July 19, 1991 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 11149 was issued to Layne-Western Co., Inc. for said filing fee.


The applicant was notified on March 18, 1992 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 10, 1992 at 9:30 A.M. in Las Vegas, Nevada.<sup>1</sup>

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of the Regulation and experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of James Thomas Campbell on April 10, 1992.<sup>2</sup>

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of James Thomas Campbell is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller, and did not demonstrate knowledge of the Regulations for Water Well and Related Drilling.
