RULING #4390

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Todd G. DeLong in the office of the State Engineer on May 12, 1995 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 12853 was issued to Todd G. DeLong for said filing fee.

The applicant was notified on September 15, 1995 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 12, 1995 at 8:00 A.M., in Carson City, Nevada.¹ The applicant's examination was cancelled.


The applicant was notified on December 8, 1995 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board on January 11, 1996 at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada.¹ On December 27, 1995 the applicant cancelled his examination.

The applicant was notified on March 15, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board on April 11, 1996 at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada.¹ The applicant appeared as scheduled, scored 74 on the written examination, and failed Part II, identifying a location on a topographic map. The Board recommended the denial of the application of Todd G. DeLong on April 11, 1996 because this was the third time Mr. DeLong was scheduled and didn't pass the examination.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Todd G. DeLong is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
