RULING #4470

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Jeff A. Hammer in the office of the State Engineer on April 22, 1996 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 13455 was issued to The Verde Companies for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on April 22, 1996. A response was received from two of the individuals. The applicant was notified on September 13, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 11, 1996 at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by (illegible signature) on September 17, 1996.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Jeff A. Hammer on October 11, 1996.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Jeff A. Hammer is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
