RULING #4551

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Philip Mulford in the office of the State Engineer on December 12, 1996, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 14002 was issued to Diamond Well Drilling Co for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on December 12, 1996. All references were received. The applicant was notified on June 18, 1997, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on July 18, 1997, at 8:30 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Diane Stevenson on June 24, 1997.<sup>1</sup>

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Philip Mulford on July 18, 1997.<sup>2</sup>

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Philip Mulford is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant


