FINDINGS OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Jerry J. Jensen in the office of the State Engineer on July 14, 1997, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 14530 was issued to Jensen Driller Company for said filing fee.


Four references were on file from a previous application. The applicant was notified on September 9, 1997, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Jamie Grover on September 12, 1997.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Jerry J. Jensen on October 9, 1997.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282, subsection 2, the application of Jerry J. Jensen is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
