RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by James Moore in the office of the State Engineer on January 13, 1998 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 14558 was issued to Andresen Exploration Drilling.

The applicant was notified on July 10, 1998 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on August 14, 1998 in Carson City, Nevada.¹ He appeared as scheduled and failed the written examination.

The applicant was notified on October 7, 1998 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on November 5, 1998 in Carson City, Nevada. He appeared as scheduled and failed the written examination.¹

The applicant was notified on April 12, 1999 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 6, 1999 in Carson City, Nevada. The applicant appeared as scheduled passed the written examination and failed Part II, identification of a location on a topographic map. The Board recommended denial of the application of Randy Taylor Barr on November 5, 1998, because this was the third time Mr. Barr was scheduled and didn't pass the examination.²
