FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Daniel Scott Alkema in the office of the State Engineer on November 15, 1999 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 15639 was issued to Points West Drilling for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on November 15, 1999. No response was received from the requests. The applicant was notified on April 10, 2000 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 4, 2000 at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail was returned stamped "Unclaimed Return to Sender".¹ The applicant was also notified by regular mail at his residential mailing address after his employer notified this office he was employed elsewhere.

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Daniel Scott Alkema on May 4, 2000.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Daniel Scott Alkema is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
