RULING # 5050

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Kenneth Paul Kimbal, Sr. in the office of the State Engineer on March 12, 2001 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 16232 was issued to Riverside Electric Motors & Pumps for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on March 12, 2001. References were received from all of the requests. The applicant was notified on April 17, 2001 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 10, 2001 at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Danine K. Avery on April 18, 2001.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Kenneth Paul Kimbal, Sr. on May 10, 2001.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Kenneth Paul Kimbal, Sr. is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
