RULING # 5051

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Michael A. Simpson in the office of the State Engineer on July 20, 2000 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 16173 was issued to Layne Christensen Company for said filing fee.

The applicant was notified on April 17, 2001 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 11, 2001 at 8:30 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulations and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant did not have at least 2 years of experience appropriate for a well drilling license, required by NAC § 534.282(1)(B). The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Michael A. Simpson on May 11, 2001.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Michael A. Simpson is herewith denied on the grounds that he and his application did not comply with the Regulations.
