RULING # 5067

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Celdon Lee Chambers in the office of the State Engineer on April 6, 2001 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 16236 was issued to Beylik Well Drilling for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on April 11, 2001. References were received from two of the requests. The applicant was notified on July 16, 2001 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on August 9, 2001 at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail was returned by the U.S. Postal Service on August 13, 2001, marked "UNCLAIMED".<sup>1</sup>

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Celdon Lee Chambers on August 9, 2001.<sup>2</sup>

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Celdon Lee Chambers is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
