RULING #5137

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by James C. Christian in the office of the State Engineer on May 7, 2001, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 16241 was issued to Boart Longyear for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on May 8, 2001. References were received from all of the requests. The applicant was notified on April 17, 2002, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 10, 2002, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by John P. Charlton on April 19, 2002.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of James C. Christian on May 10, 2002.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of James C. Christian is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
