FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Don L. Youngblood in the office of the State Engineer on September 13, 2004, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 18271 was issued to Prosonic Corp. for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on September 14, 2004. References were received from all of the requests. The applicant was notified on October 7, 2004, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on November 5, 2004, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Lisa Ellington on October 12, 2004.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Don L. Youngblood on November 5, 2004.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Don L. Youngblood is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
