FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Arnold Lamon in the office of the State Engineer on May 7, 2010, together with the statutory filing fee.¹

Requests for four references were mailed on May 7, 2010. Responses were received from all of the requests. The Applicant was notified on July 12, 2010, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on August 11, 2010, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas. The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear.² The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Arnold Lamon on August 11, 2010.


CONCLUSION

The State Engineer concludes that the Applicant failed to notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear as scheduled as required in the NAC § 534.282, (2) (a).

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board and the application of Arnold Lamon is herewith denied pursuant to NAC 534.282 (2)(a) that the Applicant failed to notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear.
