FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Murrell Redding, Jr. in the office of the State Engineer on September 14, 2010, together with the statutory filing fee.¹

Requests for four references were mailed on September 14, 2010. Responses were received from two of the requests. The Applicant was notified on October 8, 2010, to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on November 4, 2010, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas. The certified letter was unclaimed after the United States Post Office attempted to deliver. The applicant failed Part I of the written examination with a score of 55, a score of 70 is passing.²

The Applicant was notified on January 12, 2011, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on February 10, 2011, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas. Again, the certified letter was unclaimed after the United States Post Office attempted to deliver. The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear.³ The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Murrell Redding, Jr. on February 10, 2011.

CONCLUSION


The State Engineer concludes that the Applicant failed to notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear as scheduled as required in the NAC § 534.282, (2) (a).
