

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION FOR WELL
DRILLER'S LICENSE FILED ON OCTOBER 23,
1962, BY CARL L. CROSBY

R U L I N G

General:

An application for Well Driller's License was received October 23, 1962, from Carl L. Crosby. The application was accompanied by the statutory filing fee of \$25.00 and was filed as provided under NRS 534.140.

In accordance with the procedure of processing applications for well driller's licenses, notices for recommendations were mailed to the references listed on the application. The following notices were mailed on the dates listed:

12/10/62 Mr. Carl A. Doer, Box 3312, North Las Vegas, Nevada.
12/10/62 Cowley Bros., Drilling Contractors, St. Johns, Ariz.

The recommendations were received by January 23, 1963, and referred to the Southern Nevada Well Drillers Advisory Board for review. They recommended that the "application be denied" because:

"We have found that the applicant has applied for a 'limited' driller's license to drill wells on his own property with drilling equipment which we think is inadequate to properly drill water wells."

"We also find that the applicant has resided in Nevada since approximately 1951 and during this time has been connected with the drilling of only three wells, some of which have been finished by other licensed drillers, due to the inferior equipment that the applicant has tried to use."

RULING

The Application for Well Driller's License of Carl L. Crosby is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant is not properly qualified and that its granting would be detrimental to the public welfare.
