Subject: Plugged and Abandoned Water Well at 630 South Rancho Road

Gentlemen:


This letter is to document our telephone conversation on April 9, 1992 during which we discussed the well abandonment at 630 South Rancho Road. The contractor, CEL Development, Inc., noted on the plan for the new building that the well was to be abandoned per "Health Regulations." CEL contacted the Clark County Health District (CCHD) and was informed that CCHD did not have any regulations regarding well abandonment. It is not clear which department at CCHD was contacted.

The contractor then abandoned the well in a manner that would not interfere with the construction of the new building. The eight-inch well casing was cut six feet below grade and the well filled with concrete to make sure it would not interfere with the footings of the new building. You stated that as long as the well was plugged, and since it is now under the new building, you consider the matter closed. I am enclosing a copy of the Well Log and a letter dated March 23, 1992 from CEL to Mr. Dean Goodale of your office explaining the abandonment.


In response to your recent request for information regarding the abandoned water well at 630 S. Rancho, I submit the following information:

On or about August 8, 1990 while overexcavating the Building pad for the new structure, we cut the 8" well casing off about 6 feet below the then existing grade. Our soils report indicated an overexcavation of the existing soils to 3 feet below any footings and the well casing was going to be under the new Building. We wanted to be sure the casing and the concrete cap were not going to interfere with any of the Building concrete.

Since the site plan for the new Building noted the "Well to be abandoned per Health Regulations" and the Clark County Health Dept. informed us they did not have any regulations regarding this, we filled the casing full of concrete.

If I can be of further assistance, please let me know.
