Dear Mr. Al Rushanan:

SECOR International Incorporated (SECOR) on behalf of its client, The Southland Corporation (Southland) is providing this well abandonment report. Well abandonment activities were conducted pursuant to Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) correspondence dated June 2, 1998 which granted administrative closure of the site. SECOR submitted a workplan for closure activities that was approved by NDEP on February 17, 1998.

SECOR personnel supervised well abandonment of MW-2 through MW-10, and RW-1 through RW-5 (Figure 1) on October 1-2, 1998. Weber Drilling Services, a State of Nevada licensed driller, was contracted to abandon the wells. Each well was abandoned by removing the well casings. The well cover and concrete well pads were chipped out. Debris from the wells were disposed of in an on-site dumpster. The wells were then grouted and topped with cement. The boreholes were filled in with cement to match the parking lot surface and sealed.

An Intent to Drill Card and Well Drillers Reports were submitted to the Nevada Division of Water Resources by the driller.
