This letter is to inform you that on 27 August 1990, two piezometers (P-4 and P-7) and one monitoring well (MW-1) located at Harrah's Lake Tahoe Resort Casino (Harrah's), NW1/4 Section 27, T.13N, R.18E, M.D.B. & M were abandoned. The piezometers and monitoring well were installed as per your authorization letters dated 3 April 1989 (Waiver MO-140) and 19 April 1990 (Waiver MO-245), respectively. The attached figure shows the locations of the piezometers and monitoring well.

The piezometers and monitoring well were installed in April 1989 and March 1990, respectively, as part of Harrah's underground storage tank compliance program. The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP), in their 7 June 1990 letter, determined that groundwater had not been impacted by leakage from underground storage tanks, and further monitoring was not required. As a result, it was decided to abandon the piezometers and monitoring well.

The piezometers and monitoring well were plugged by a State of Nevada licensed driller in accordance with State of Nevada Regulations for Water Well and Related Drilling, dated January 1990. Because the driller was not able to remove the piezometer casings, the casings were left in place and the abandonments were accomplished by pressure grouting using neat cement. Monitoring well MW-1 was over drilled to remove the casing using 8-inch hollow-stem augers. The resulting boring was grouted from the well bottom to the surface using neat cement.

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
