Gentlemen:

This letter is to inform you of the plugging process of the well located on the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 Sec 35 T16N R24E in Lyon County, permit# 27664, parcel #2, Buckland Station River Ranch. This letter will supersede any previous information on this hole as it explains the exact process of the final plugging of the well. On August 13, 1990, before the new well was drilled, the hole was circulated from the bottom with mud. 68 bags of mud were used. The muds viscosity and weight were 60 vis and 10 lb mud. We had placed a plug, perforated, and filled the hole with concrete, but as there was no original surface seal, we drilled this out while it was still green. We then, on 11/20/90, placed a plug at 50'. (there is a hole in the casing at 55') The casing was then perforated by using a turtle back perforator. This places a 3/8" cut in the casing, two cuts per application. The perforations were applied every foot to 50' from 2' below the surface. There were four rows of these. We then moved the SIMCO rig on and mixed neat cement with the mud pump and pumped it through the pipe from 50' to the surface. The neat cement was mixed using 6 gallons of water to every 94lb bag of Portland Cement. 56 bags of cement were used. The abandonment was completed on 11/23/90.
