Subject: Informal Field Investigation

On July 6, 1989, a follow-up field investigation was performed by Robert Martinez of the Division of Water Resources

At approximately 3:00 P.M. I, Robert Martinez, arrived at the location in the Mound House area, and met with Julius Bunkowski.

Mr. Bunkowski informed me that around 3 cubic yards of cement grout mixed at 5 sacks per cubic yard was used to plug the original well under Permit 46625. He also showed me photos of the plugging operation. The photos were of the pumper and hose going down the well casing and the cement truck.

The well location under Permit 46624 was also shown to me.
