Re: Well Abandonments Rennox 1, 2, and Tobar

Dear Tom:

Three wells were abandoned by Reynolds Drilling for the Union Pacific Railroad, locations, descriptions, and methods of abandonments are listed below.

43099 A

Rennox 6" well site [redacted] Well as found to be 96' deep. Perforated casing to 43' - ran trammi to 92' - pumped bentonite to surface - pulled up to 50' and pumped in hole plug - pulled up 2' and pumped neat cement to surface.

43100 B

Rennox 8" well site [redacted] Well found to be 80' deep. Abandoned in similar fashion as Rennox 6" well.

43268 C

Tobar 6" well site [redacted] The well was perforated from 50' to top of existing perforations. Ran 1 1/4" pipe in well - mixed mud and circulated well full of bentonite - pulled up 1 1/4" pipe to 50' and pumped in hole plug bentonite. Mixed neat cement and pumped that in to the surface.
