RE: Plugging of Monitoring Well

Dear Mr. Gallagher:




FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF MONITORING WELL BOREHOLE AT CHEMLINE WORLD INDUSTRIES. BOREHOLE PLUGGED ON 7 FEBRUARY 1992 BY RESOURCE CONCEPTS, INC.

On 29 January 1992, Andreason Drilling (Reno, Nevada) under the direction of Resource Concepts, Inc., drilled a 40 foot deep borehole using a hollow stem auger for a monitoring well at the Chemiline World Industries, Inc., property, in Carson City, Nevada (Figure 1). No groundwater was encountered, so the borehole was allowed to stand for 24 hours, and still, no groundwater was encountered.

The absence of groundwater at a depth of 40 feet or less was discussed with Mr. Joe Livak (Nevada Division of Environmental Protection) in light of the environmental concerns associated with this property. It was decided that further drilling was not warranted, and plugging of the well was recommended.




FIGURE 2. PLUG PROCEDURE FOR MONITORING WELL LOCATED AT CHEMLINE WORLD INDUSTRIES, CARSON CITY, NEVADA.

This letter serves to notify you that on 7 February 1992, the borehole was plugged pursuant to NAC 534.421 by Resource Concepts, Inc.. The specific methodology is outlined in Figure 2.
