


This letter is in regard to the destruction of one, (1) monitor well located at NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 62 East, MDB&M, Clark County, Nevada.

The destruction of the monitor well was on September 3, 1991, by Layne Environmental of Tempe, Arizona and observed by Converse Environmental Consultants Southwest, Inc. Schedule 40, 4-inch PVC well casing and screen was removed by drilling. All sand and bentonite was removed and a neat cement grout was poured from a depth of 126 feet to the surface.
