Dear Ms Presto Sario:

This is in reply to your written request of October 27, 1997, for permission to deepen your well at 12200 Thomas Creek Road which serves lots described by Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APN) 152-030-01 and 152-030-02. The State Engineer has discretionary authority under Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 534.120 subsection 3 (c) & (d) as to domestic wells in designated groundwater basins where water can be furnished by a municipality or a water district. Water service can be furnished by Sierra Pacific Power Company to your lots.

Authorization is hereby allowed to deepen your well which serves lots described above. The reason for allowing deepening of the well is the cost difference between deepening and the connection and service line costs of water service from Sierra Pacific Power Company. However, if there are problems and a replacement or new well is required, a replacement or new well is hereby denied by NRS 534.120 subsection 3 (d), connection to water service provided by Sierra Pacific Power Company is required, and your existing well must be plugged and abandoned in accordance with Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 534.420.

A copy of this waiver must be provided to the well driller, he must note the waiver on his Notice of Intent card, and must have a copy of the waiver on the drill site.
