

**SUBJECT: REQUEST TO MODIFY COMPLETION DESIGN FOR TWO MONITORING WELLS UNDER WAIVER R-1260**

The Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) received Waiver R-1260 associated with the drilling and completion of ten monitoring wells from the Nevada Division of Water Resources in a letter dated September 16, 2004. Two monitoring wells proposed in Delamar Valley 182M-1 and 182W906M were approved for 6-inch and 12-inch casing respectively. After further evaluation of the subsurface geology it is SNWA's desire to switch the proposed completions for the two monitoring wells. The proposed completions for 182M-1 will consist of 12-inch casing and the completion for 182W906M will consist of 6-inch casing. The parcel numbers and legal descriptions for the two Delamar Valley monitoring wells are listed in the following table and depicted on the enclosed map.





This addendum to existing waiver R-1260 is to allow for the change of location and installation of two (2) monitor wells referenced in Waiver R-1260. Well 182M-1 located within the NE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 18, T.7S., R.63E, APN 008-091-01 is to be completed using 12-inch well casing and 182W906M located with the SE ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 19, T.7S., R.64 E, APN 008-091-02 is to be completed using 6-inch well casing.

Dear Mr. Albright:

Under the provisions of the Regulations for Water Well and Related Drilling, Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 534, Revised and Adopted in January 1998 and for good cause shown, authorization is herewith granted to install the subject wells as described in you letter filed April 11, 2005.


This office waives only a portion of NAC 534.4355(3) and NAC 534.4357. Full compliance with the remainder of the statute and regulation is required. Please include as accurate a description as possible of the location of the well on the well drillers report. It is expressly understood that this is authorization does not relieve the operator of the permitting requirements of other state, federal and local agencies.

The well must be drilled by a well driller licensed in the State of Nevada. The well drillers report, when filed, shall bear Waiver No.R-1260A and the name and license number of the driller performing the work.
