1. The source of water is AN UNDERGROUND SOURCE, PAHRUMP VALLEY BASIN Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0298 c.f.s., but not to exceed 10 acre feet Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point Government Lot #1, Section 36, T.21 S., R.53 E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada or at a point from which the Northeast corner of said Section 36 bears North 51°47'09" East a distance of 322.19 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within Government Lot #1, Section 36, T.21 S., R.53 E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada or a a point from which the Northeast Corner of said Section 36, bears North 54°31'00" East a distance of 175.00 feet.

7. Proposed place of use within Government Lot #1, Sectopm 36. T.21S., R.53 E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada (consisting of 2 acre's)

8. Existing place of use within Government Lot #1, Section 36, T.21 S., R.53 E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada (consisting of 2 acres's)

9. Use will be from JANUARY 1 to DECEMBER 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from JANUARY 1 to DECEMBER 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 21049 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 21049 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.0298..... cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 10 acre-

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... January 18, 1992
