Place of Use and Point of Diversion of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 24004, Certificate No. 9075

1. The source of water is. underground

2. The amount of water to be changed. 0.97 cfs - 700 acre feet per annum

3. The water to be used for. wildlife propagation and recreation

4. The water heretofore permitted for. wildlife propagation and recreation

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point. in the NW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 25, T16N, R19E, M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 25 bears N 71° 20' W, a distance of 3,921 feet

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within. SE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 36, T17N, R19E, M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 36 bears N 89° 48' 45" E, a distance of 40.45 feet

7. Proposed place of use. Portions of the following: SE1/4 Section 23, S1/2 Section 24, N1/2 Section 25, and NE1/4 Section 26, all in T16N, R19E, M.D.B. & M.; SW1/4 Section 19, and NW1/4 Section 30, all in T16N, R20E, M.D.B. & M.

8. Existing place of use. Portions of Section 1, T16N, R19E, M.D.B. & M., and Section 36, T17N, R19E, M.D.B. & M.

9. Use will be from. January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from. January 1 to December 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:
This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 24004, Certificate 9075 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24004, Certificate 9075 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 59382, 59383, 59384, 59385 and 59868 shall not exceed 731.16 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.967 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 700.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 22, 1996
Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 22, 1996
Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 22, 1999
Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 22, 1999

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

All surface waters shall be used for wildlife purposes prior to the use of any supplemental ground water.



ATTACHMENT FOR ITEM NO. 11 - REMARKS

This 700 acre feet of water will be used to supplement surface water sources to maintain the wildlife and wetland mitigation area in the proposed place of use at the south end of Washoe Lake. There will be a corresponding reduction in the supplemental amount of water rights, by 700 acre feet, within the existing place of use as defined in this application to change.
