of water heretofore appropriated under 54866 Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed .49 CFS., 17 AFA Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 33, T.15N R.20E. If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer. M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 33 bears South 85° 16' West 1586 Ft.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54866 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54866 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.49 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 17.0 acre-feet annually.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from the well and the amount of water used.
