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The applicant Stagecoach General Improvement District, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 56451

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1. The source of water is Underground - Churchill Downs Well
2. The amount of water to be changed 1.911 c.f.s., 146.166 mga
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.17N., R.23E., MDM, or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 9 bears North 11<sup>o</sup> 19' 35" East, a distance of 665.53 feet
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 35, T.18N., R.23E., MDM, or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 35 bears South 83<sup>o</sup> West, 925 feet
7. Proposed place of use See attached

Existing place of use all of Sections 1 and 2, E $\frac{1}{2}$  W $\frac{1}{2}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 3, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 10, N $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 11, N $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 12, T.17N., R.23E., E $\frac{1}{2}$  W $\frac{1}{2}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 34, all of Sections 35 and 36, T.18N., R.23E., MDM
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works well, pump, motor and distribution system
12. Estimated cost of works approximately \$500,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 10 years
15. Remarks: Stagecoach General Improvement District plans to ultimately become the primary water purveyor in the place of use and participate actively in the management of this ground water sub-basin. It is not the intent of this application to restrict or prevent use of existing water rights within the proposed place of use.

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56451 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56451 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 56450, 56451, 56454, 57841, 58067, 58068, 61078, 61769, 62517, 62518, 62869, and 63643 shall not exceed 230.39 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.911 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 146.166 million gallons annually.
