The applicant Washoe County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of water heretofore appropriated under portions of Claims 153 and 168 of the Truckee River Decree, said Decree entered by the District Court of the United States for Nevada in that certain action entitled "The United States of America vs. Orr Water Ditch Company, et al., Defendants", in Equity Docket Docket A-3.

1. The source of water is Truckee River by Last Chance Ditch, as decreed
2. The amount of water to be changed 2.835 afa and a prorata share of the diversion rate
3. The water to be used for Municipal and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for As Decreed
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point The points of diversion of Sierra Pacific's existing water treatment plants as described in attached Exhibit "A" and as shown on the map supporting Application No. 58882 on file with the Division of Water Resources, State of Nevada.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the Northeast corner of said Section 14 bears North 24 26' East a distance of 1840 feet. Last Chance Ditch per Orr Ditch Decree. See Map No. 58810 for existing point of diversion.
7. Proposed place of use See attached Exhibit "B" and maps supporting Applications No. 57410 and No. 62187, on file with the State Engineer.
8. Existing place of use 0.30 acres within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Washoe County Assessor's Parcel No. 10-442-26 and 0.33 acres within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Washoe County Assessor's Parcel No. 18-063-06, all in T.19N., R.19E., M.D.M..
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from As Decreed to As Decreed of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Water will be diverted by existing S.P.P.Co. facilities, treated and delivered to Washoe County through S.P.P.Co.'s existing distribution system.
12. Estimated cost of works In excess of \$50 million.
13. Estimated time required to construct works Completed
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 10 years
15. Remarks: Sierra Pacific Power Company (S.P.P.Co.) is the wholesale supplier to Washoe County for the specific purpose of diverting,

treating and delivering the water required under the wholesale agreement. This application transfers 2.835 acre feet of water for future use by Washoe County.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claims 153 & 168, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.009 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 2.79 acre-feet as decreed.**






EXHIBIT "A"

The following describes the multiple points of diversion for Sierra Pacific Power Company Water Treatment Plants, which are shown on the map accompanying Application No. 58882 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources, more particularly described as follows:

STEAMBOAT CANAL (HUNTER CREEK RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE1/4 SW1/4) of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 31 bears South 62°04' East, a distance of 3,195.00 feet.

HIGHLAND DITCH (HIGHLAND RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW1/4 SE1/4) of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1,650.00 feet.

IDLEWILD TREATMENT PLANT:

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SE1/4 SE1/4) of Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 10 bears South 69°57'58" East, a distance of 842.34 feet.

NORTH TRUCKEE DITCH (GLENDALE TREATMENT PLANT):

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (SW1/4 NE1/4) of Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Northeast corner of said Section 7 bears North 39°28' East, a distance of 3,015.00 feet.

ORR DITCH PUMP STATION (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):

The point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (NE1/4 SE1/4) of Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion the Northeast corner of said Section 17 bears North 15°39'36" East, a distance of 3,264.77 feet.

ORR DITCH (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):

The point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE1/4 SW1/4) of Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion the Southwest corner of said Section 17 bears South 44°40' West, a distance of 3,211.00 feet.




