The applicant Washoe County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Place of Use, and Manner of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 17566, Certificate 5425

1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.098 cfs; 14.58 AF
3. The water to be used for Municipal
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE1/4, NE1/4 Section 23, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 23 bears N. 54 31' 36" E., a distance of 1,539.98 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S1/4 corner of said Section 23 bears S. 47° 50' 00" W., a distance of 667.0 feet.
7. Proposed place of use E1/2, E1/2 W1/2 Section 23; NW1/4, W1/2 SW1/4, Section 24; N1/2 N1/2, SW1/4 NW1/4 and portion of SE1/4 NW1/4, Section 26; all in T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M
8. Existing place of use 6.46 acres in SW1/4 SE1/4 Section 23; 1.0 acre in SE1/4 SW1/4 Section 23; all in T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. Area to be stripped: 1.0 acre in SE1/4 SW1/4, and 2.65 acres in SW1/4 SE1/4, Section 23, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Well, pump, storage tank, and distribution lines.
12. Estimated cost of works 35,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works Completed
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 10 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 17566, Certificate 5425 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 17566, Certificate 5425 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 34738, 58615, 59703, 63357, 63358, 64023, and 64343 shall not exceed 27.3150 million gallons annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.098 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 4.7509 million gallons annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

February 11, 2002

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

March 11, 2002

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

February 11, 2005

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 11, 2005

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


