PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

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The applicant William Joseph Richter, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 57805-Certificate 14480

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1. The source of water is an underground source
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.4122 CFS not to exceed 81.750 AFA
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for recreation and domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, T.12N, R20E, MDM or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 31 bears S 08<sup>0</sup> 39' 02" E, 1848.83 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, T14N, R20E, MDB&M or at a point from which the NW corner of said section 30 bears NO 7<sup>0</sup> 50' 00" W, a distance of 2200.00 feet.
7. Proposed place of use 20.438 acres within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, T12N, R20E, MDM (Parcel 31-020-67), Douglas County, Nevada.
8. Existing place of use portions of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, T14N, R20E, MDB&M, Douglas County, Nevada
9. Use will be from 1 January to 31 December of each year.
10. Use was permitted from 1 January to 31 December of each year.
11. Description of proposed works 8 inch well, submersible pump, and sprinkler wheel lines
12. Estimated cost of works \$35,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 3 years
15. Remarks: Use the map on file under Permit 57804 to show the existing point of diversion and place of use. Permit 57805 changed the manner of use of Permit 37953 which was granted for irrigation purposes. We are requesting that the manner of use of Permit 57805 be changed back to the use approved in the original Permit.

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 57805 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 57805 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

With the issuance of Permit 64613, the total combined duty for 57805, 59294, 59295, 62334, 62335, 62336 and 62337 is reduced to 100.55 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.4122 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 81.75 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

June 30, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

July 30, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 30, 2001

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 30, 2001

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 30, 2001
