The applicant **Ronald E. Hamilton and Ellen S. Goldsmith**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 56046

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.0582525 c.f.s., 13.5 AFA**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Quasi-Municipal**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.13N., R.20E., MDM, or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 27 bears South 45°59' East, 288 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T.14N., R.20E., MDM, or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 33 bears North 50°03' West, 3201 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.13N., R.20E., MDM. Irrigation will be limited to 3.375 acres within the area shown on the supporting map.**
8. Existing place of use **S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34, E $\frac{1}{2}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T.14N., R.20E., MDM**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **drilled well, pump and motor, and irrigation distribution system**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$25,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **1 year**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**
15. Remarks: **Use map on file at the Division of Water Resources under Application 31222 to support the existing point of diversion and place of use. The proposed point of diversion is an existing domestic well and the water under this application is to be commingled with the domestic allocation of 2.02 AFA, for a total combined usage of 15.52 AFA. The Report of Conveyance and a letter withdrawing the supplemental portion of Permit 56047 are being filed concurrently with this application.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56046 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56046 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

This permit is issued for the irrigation of 3.375 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0583 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 13.5 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

April 14, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

May 14, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 14, 2001

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 14, 2001

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 14, 2001
