APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 25690, Certificate 9215 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 25690, Certificate 9215 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Temporary Permit 66561-T and any waters of the Walker River Decree and any storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 17.28 acre-feet per year for the irrigation of 4.32 acres. The permittee is responsible for insuring delivery of the entitled decreed and storage waters that are supplemental to Temporary Permit 66561-T. In any year that the Walker River Irrigation District declares a full allocation of decreed waters to the priority years of C-125 claims supplemental to Temporary Permit 66561-T, underground water shall not be pumped from the wells described in these permits. In any year that the Walker River Irrigation District has no decreed or storage water, or declares a reduced allocation of surface waters to the priority years of C-125 claims supplemental to Temporary Permit 66561-T, then the place of use of the permits can be irrigated with underground water, but not to exceed duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre per year from the total of decreed, storage, and underground waters.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **August 22, 2001** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0715 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 17.28 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:


