The applicant **DOUGLAS COUNTY**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, AND MANNER OF USE OF A PORTION** of water heretofore appropriated under **PERMIT 64027**

1. The source of water is **AN UNDERGROUND SOURCE**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.1658 cfs (33.45 acre feet / 10.90 mga)**
3. The water to be used for **RECREATION (GOLF COURSE IRRIGATION)**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions.

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 64027 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 64027 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The issuance of Temporary Permit 67401-T reduces the total combined duty of Permits 64027, 64994 and 67186-T to 337.86 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **May 24, 2002** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.1658 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 33.45 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:



EXHIBIT "B"

A temporary Application to Change is being submitted to provide a temporary water supply to Sunridge Corporation for development of a permanent water supply and effluent management program for their golf course.

The County has negotiated a short-term (5 year) lease agreement with Sunridge Corporation for the use of a portion of Permit 64027 for irrigation of the Sunridge golf course. It is the County's intention to move the referenced water right (a portion of 64027) back to the East Valley Water System for domestic and M&I use upon termination of the lease agreement. These rights are currently in excess of the East Valley Water System demand, but will be needed to meet future system demands.
