The applicant Pahrump Homestead Partners hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner of Use and Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under a portion of Permit No. 29050, C. 9181

- 1. The source of water is **Underground**
- 2. The amount of water to be changed **10 Acre-Feet at 0.0357 cfs**
- 3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
- 4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
- 5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in **"Government Lot 14"** of the NW¼ of Section 6, T22N, R55E, M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada, at a point from which the Northwest corner of said Section 6 bears N 15° 54' 46" W, 952.50 feet.
- 6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within The SW¼ SW¼ Section 8, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 8 bears S. 19° 03' W., a distance of 1,077.00 feet.
- 7. Proposed place of use **"Government Lot 14"** of the NE¼ of Section 6, T22S, R54E, M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada.
- 8. Existing place of use **2.00 acres of the original 3.8 acres in the NW¼ SW¼ of Section 8, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.M. are to be removed from irrigation. Refer to supporting map submitted with this application.**
- 9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
- 10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
- 11. Description of proposed works **Existing underground well pressure tanks and service lines.**
- 12. Estimated cost of works **Temporary use of existing well and system will have no cost**
- 13. Estimated time required to construct works **None (Existing)**
- 14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Immediately**
- 15. Remarks: **Water to be used to service existing "Bed and Breakfast", Shop, and Brothel temporarily until application for new commercial well, P.O.D, P.O.U, and M.O.U, for this water right and others being purchased can be completed. All appropriate maps, including maps for removal from irrigation will be submitted with application.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 29050, Certificate 9181, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 29050, Certificate 9181, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0358 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 10.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

January 18, 2003

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

February 18, 2003

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

January 18, 2005

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 18, 2005

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


