The applicant Washoe County and the City of Reno hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 68666, which changed portions of Claims 177/204 & 178/262 of the Truckee River Decree, said Decree entered by the District Court of the United States for Nevada in that certain action entitled, "The United States of America, Plaintiff, vs. Orr Water Ditch Company, et al., Defendants", in Equity Docket A-3.

1. The source of water is Truckee River
2. The amount of water to be changed 80.00 afa and a prorata share of the diversion rate
3. The water to be used for As decreed
4. The water heretofore permitted for Recreational (irrigation of golf course)
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 19, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the northeast corner of said Section 19 bears South 88°05' East a distance of 2620 feet. Lake Ditch per Orr Ditch Decree. See Map No. 58923 for proposed point of diversion.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NE ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the southeast corner of said Section 31 bears South 62°04' East a distance of 3195 feet. Steamboat Canal per Orr Ditch Decree. See Map No. 55052 for existing point of diversion.
7. Proposed place of use Portions of SE¼ SW¼ & S½ SE¼ Sec 36 19N 19E & SW¼ SW¼ Sec 31 19N 20E MDB&M 18.823 acs within Washoe County Assessor's Parcel No. 040-162-55 as shown on map TR-034, on file with the Nevada State Engineer.
8. Existing place of use 18.823 acres within Washoe County Assessor's Parcel Nos. 019-140-12 and 13, as shown on Map TR-055, on file with the Nevada State Engineer. a portion of the W½ E½ and the E½ W½ Section 23 T19N R19E MDB&M
9. Use will be from As Decreed.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Water will be diverted by existing works from the Lake Ditch.
12. Estimated cost of works Completed.
13. Estimated time required to construct works Not applicable.
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 1 year

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 68666 which changed the Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion of Claim No. 177/204 & 178/262, Truckee River Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This temporary permit is limited to the irrigation of 18.823 acres within the proposed place of use.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation of the Federal Water Master.

The issuance of this temporary permit reduces the place of use of Permit 68666 to 121.32 acres.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on October 15, 2005 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.347 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed 80 acre-feet as decreed

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:


