APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 41159, Certificate 13215, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 41159, Certificate 13215 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records must be submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 41159, 41160, 65105, 69248, 69694, 71224, 72047, 72048, 72108, 73077 and 73078, having the same point of diversion - Well # 5, shall not exceed 1.526 cubic feet per second and 811.577 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 71871, 72037 thru 72050, 72388, 72389, 72390, 73075 thru 73088, 74241 and 74242, being owned by Adaven for Quasi-Municipal purposes, shall not exceed 8.66 cubic feet per second and 3026.70 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

Any dedication of water from this permit for residential service shall be allocated at the tiered dedication rate prescribed, by letter dated November 4, 2008, by the State Engineer and as dictated by the stipulated agreement dated March 10, 2009.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.296 cubic feet per second or 176.64 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:



This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 65105, 65106, 69248, 69249, 69694, 70408, 70873 and 71224 shall not exceed 946.18 acre-feet annually; and the total combined duty of water under Permits 72037, 72038, 72039, 72040, 72041, 72042, 72043, 72044, 72045, 72046, 72047, 72048, 72049, 72050, 73075, 73076, 73077, 73078, 73079, 73080, 73081, 73082, 73083, 73084, 73085, 73086, 73087 and 73088 shall not exceed 1474.63 acre-feet annually for a total duty of 2420.81 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit is for the consumptive use portion only, being 123.65 acre-feet of the 176.64 acre-feet portion of the base right. The remainder, 52.99 acre-feet, remains in the groundwater source. The issuance of this permit abrogates 176.64 acre-feet from Permit 41159.
