APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 23943, Certificate 7040 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 23943, Certificate 7040 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 73527, 73528 and 74029, having a comingled place of use shall not exceed 0.5765 cubic feet per second and 168.5 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 41164, 41171, 41172, 58956, 72038, 72039, 72043, 73082, 73086, 73087, 73528, 74931, and 74933, having the same point of diversion, shall not exceed 3.804 cubic feet per second and 1542.69 acre-feet annually for all purposes. Any use of water from this well for irrigation purposes shall be metered separately.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

Any dedication of water from this permit for a residential subdivision shall be allocated at 1.12 acre-feet per lot. The State Engineer may amend the per lot allocation based on evidence and data supporting such change.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.2707 cubic feet per second or 79.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

October 30, 2009

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

October 30, 2017

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

The applicant **Triple Tech, LLC** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place of Use and Manner of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 23943, Certificate 7040**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.27075 c.f.s., 79 AFA**
3. The water to be used for **Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.21 S., R.54 E., MDM, or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 8 bears North 24° 59' 30" East, a distance of 2,855 feet, situated in Nye County, Nevada. (Pahrump Utility Company, Inc. Well #3B)**
