APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of a portion of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 45661, Certificate 11022 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 45661, Certificate 11022 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 69667 and 74130, having the same point of diversion, shall not exceed 0.2276 cubic feet per second and 45.0 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 67662, 69667 and 74130, having a comingled place of use shall not exceed 55.0 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

Permit 74130 is issued for quasi-municipal purposes for the parcels identified by the Nye County Assessor as APN's 45-471-08 and 45-471-09.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.2136 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 40.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 12, 2008

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 12, 2010

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

The applicant **Mid-Valley Enterprises, LLC** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of diversion Place of use Manner of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 45661, Cert. 11022**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.2136 cfs, 40 acre-feet, 8 acres**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within Govt. Lot 14 of the NW ¼ of Section 6, Township 22S, Range 54E. M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada, at a point from which the West ¼ corner of said Section 6 bears S 05°21'11" W. a distance of 2039.25 ft.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **The SW ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 12, Township 21 S. Range 53 E. M.D.B.&M., Nye County, Nevada, at a point from which the East ¼ corner of said Section 12 bears S 54°36'53" E a distance of 1833.80 ft.**
7. Proposed place of use **Within Govt. Lots 14 and 18 of the NW ¼, Govt. Lot 19 and the NE ¼ of the SW ¼, the NW ¼ SE ¼ and the NE ¼ of the SE ¼, the SW ¼ NE ¼ and the SE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 6, T 22S. R 54E, M.D.B. & M., Nye County, Nevada. Known as APN 45-471-08 and 45-471-09 as shown on Document 622686 dated 4/29/05.**
8. Existing place of use **8.0 acres removed from irrigation within the SE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 12, T 21S, R 53 E, M.D.B. & M., Nye County, Nevada**
9. Use will be from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **existing well casing, submergible pump, pressure tank, totalizing meter, existing and proposed distribution system**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$100,000 – initial expenditure plus future improvements**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2 yrs, existing well and pump ,additional distribution system required**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 yrs.**

15. Remarks: this 40 AFA will be used to increase the water requirement for existing and proposed expansion at Shari's Ranch and Resort, consisting of additional rooms, approximately 300 R.V. spaces, landscaping, and all future development. A recently submitted 'Beneficial Use' on Permit #67662 disclosed and additional requirement for water, based on the usage at the totalizing meter. Existing permits #67662 and #69667, including this application should become supplemental to each other. Additional water is being purchased and will also be transferred to the same place of use.
