APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 77205 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 77205 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 76058 and 79030 shall not exceed the amount sufficient to water 400 cattle and 25 horses, and shall not exceed 9.52 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.026 cubic feet per second or 9.52 acre-feet annually or sufficient to water 400 cattle and 25 horses.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 15 2012

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


