CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 9 bears N. 53° 39' E., a distance of 1,922.0 situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Robert L. Service & Barbara J. Service
Post-office address: Dayton, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.07 c.f.s., but not to exceed 10.0 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
\* Date of priority of appropriation: August 12, 1954

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 2.5 Acres in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 9, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 21474, Certificate 6877, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 15767, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 15767.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
