CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Pat Glenn, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Section 23 bears N. 88° 51' 49" W., a distance of 2,054.52 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.12 c.f.s., but not to exceed 5.803 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 31, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well 84 feet deep, 6-5/8 inch casing via a pump, thence conveyed to the place of use to serve 53 trailer spaces for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes within a portion of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 23, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 22516, Certificate 8121, shall not exceed 5.803 million gallons annually.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
