CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John & Edith Beam, Permittees has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source

through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 4, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 4 bears S. 39° 10' 34" E., a distance of 1,300.74 feet

situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John and Edith Beam

Post-office address Dayton, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0253 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.52 acre-feet annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

\* Date of priority of appropriation August 12, 1954

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

1.38 Acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 21475, Certificate 6878, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 15769, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 15769.

This certificate is issued with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre or 5.52 acre-feet per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
