CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard D. Moser, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through an intake structure, piping and distribution system for Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. from which point the NE corner of said Section 7 bears N. 39°28'00" E., a distance of 3,015.00 feet (North Truckee Ditch, Glendale Treatment Plant) situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Sierra Pacific Power Company
 Source: Truckee River
 Manner of Use: Municipal
 Amount of appropriation: 0.175 c.f.s., but not to exceed 86.76 acre-feet as decreed
 Period of use: As Decreed
 Date of priority of appropriation: *January 29, 1865

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


The water is diverted from the Truckee River from where it is pumped to the Glendale Treatment Plant. After the water is treated at Glendale, it is then pumped into the water system which consists of various size piping, water storage tanks and booster pumps. The overall system ultimately conveys the treated water to Sierra Pacific Power Company's water customers within its certified water service area. Said service area is depicted by record (legal description and map) which is filed with the State Engineer's office.

*This certificate changes the manner of use and place of use of a portion of Claim 529 of the Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 529.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
