CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert R. Squires, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River, through Steamboat Canal, Highland Ditch, Idlewild Treatment Plant, and North Truckee Ditch for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

(1) Steamboat Canal (Hunter Creek Reservoir)

Located within the NE¼ SW¼ Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 62°04'00" E., a distance of 3,195.0 feet.

(2) Highland Ditch (Highland Reservoir)

Located within the SW¼ SE¼ Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 9 bears S. 75°16'00" E., a distance of 1,650.0 feet.

(3) Idlewild Treatment Plant

Located within the SE¼ SE¼ Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 10 bears S. 69°57'58" E., a distance of 842.34 feet.

(4) North Truckee Ditch (Glendale Treatment Plant)

Located within the SW¼ NE¼ Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 7 bears N. 39°28'00" E., a distance of 3,015.0 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is diverted from the Truckee River into Steamboat Canal, Highland Ditch, Idlewild Treatment Plant, and North Truckee Ditch thence the water is treated and pumped into Truckee Meadows Water Authority's water distribution system. The overall system ultimately conveys the treated water to Truckee Meadows Water Authority's water customers within its certified water service area as depicted by record (map and legal description), which is filed in the Office of the State Engineer.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Claims 454 and 455, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944); therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claims 454 and 455.


This certificate is corrected to accurately reflect the claim number and to clarify the date of priority, and it reflects the current owners of record as shown in the office of the State Engineer.

Highland Ditch (Highland Reservoir):

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 9 bears S. 75° 16' E., a distance of 1,650.0 feet.

Idlewild Treatment Plant:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 10 bears S. 69° 57' 58" E., a distance of 842.34 feet.

North Truckee Ditch (Glendale Treatment Plant):

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 7 bears N. 39° 28' E., a distance of 3,015.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:



The overall system ultimately conveys the treated water to Sierra Pacific Power Company's water customers within its certified water service area. Said service area is depicted by record (map and legal description) which is filed with the State Engineer's office.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, maner of use and place of use of a portion of Claims 455 and 241 of the Truckee River Final Decree, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 455 and 251.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
