CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Michael R. Dostie, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 7, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N¼ corner of said Section 7 bears N. 49° 59' 50" W., a distance of 281.97 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Michael R. Dostie, Helen H. Wharton, Glen H. Miller

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Irrigation and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.03465 c.f.s., but not to exceed 10.0 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: *June 3, 1960

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

2.0 acres in the NW¼ NE¼ Section 7, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 49181 which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 18901, Certificate 6108, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 18901, Certificate 6108.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
