CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Milton L. Sharp, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River (via the Lake Ditch) through a ditch, diversion box and pipeline for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 18 bears S. 88° 05' E., a distance of 2,620.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

1.76 Acres Total


*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Claims 179 and 257 of the Truckee River Final Decree in United States v. Orr Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claims 179 and 257.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty shall not exceed 4.25 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources as decreed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
