CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert H. Cantley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, motor, and distribution system for industrial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ Section 24, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 24 bears N. 68° 10' W., a distance of 477.0 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Hughes Rock and Sand, Inc.

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Industrial and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: *0.0625 c.f.s.

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: **March 11, 1970

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a 300 feet deep well with a 12.75 inch casing via a 10 H.P. pump, thence through a 2 inch distribution line to various sand and gravel wash operations and then onto various screening, settling, and dust suppression operations.

The place of use is described as being portions of the SE¼ NE¼ and NE¼ SE¼ of Section 23; portions of the NW¼ SW¼ Section 24, all in T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under Permits 51079 and 51080 shall not exceed 2.787 million gallons annually.


The total combined duty of water under Permits 39806, Certificate 11277, 51079, 51080, 51096, 51097, 58801, and 58802 shall not exceed 50.26 million gallons annually.

**This certificate changed the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of Permit 27415, Certificate 8968, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 25494, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 25494.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
