**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 27, T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 27 bears N. 06°53'15" E., a distance of 2,820.64 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lila E. Gill  
Source: Underground  
Manner of Use: Irrigation & Domestic  
Amount of appropriation: \*0.01 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.24 acre-feet annually  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: \*\*July 14, 1972

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

0.56 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 27, T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

\*The total combined rate of diversion and duty under this certificate and Permit 30793 Certificate 12759 and Permit 30795 Certificate 12760 shall not exceed 0.055 c.f.s. and 11.2 acre-feet annually. The cultivated acreage is limited to 1.4 acres on Lot 135 and 1.4 acres on Lot 136 for a total of 2.8 acres.


\*\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 28137, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 26833, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26833.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
